MOTHERBOARD REPLACED

Recently we noticed a build-up forming on the plates in the salt system cell. When it is working correctly it alternately cycles between positive and negative which removes the build-up. Ours was functioning only on the negative side, causing this problem.

Frank, Joy's husband, opened the control box and discovered it would not alternate. After a consultation with the technician it was decided the motherboard for our salt system had to be replaced.

The company sent us a reconditioned motherboard at no charge if we returned the one from our cell. Which we did.

Replacing the motherboard was a little tricky but Frank installed it and everything is working.

CLOSED DOOR POLICY

As the days become warmer our visitors sitting around the pool want to open the outside doors. When the outside temperature is 80 degrees or warmer we will open the doors.

When it is less than 80 degrees we need to leave the doors closed especially on Tuesday and Thursday when we have little children in the pool. They easily become cold when there is a cold breeze blowing across the pool.

In order for our dehumidifier to work correctly the pool room must be 2 degrees warmer than the water and our water is between 87 and 88 degrees.

If you are going to be in the building for some time wear lighter clothing.

The Rogue Valley Swim Team competed against 8 teams made up of 174 swimmers at the Woodburn Tulip Festival Meet held on Saturday, April 5th. Ten swimmers for the Rogue Valley Swim Team participated in the meet earning ten personal best times. **Austin Mortimore** qualified with an A time in the 50 yd. fly and **Sarah Mortimore** earned an A time in her 50 yd. free. **Coach Carleen Camden** was pleased with the efforts of her team.

In the 6 and under group **Marcus Gentry** placed 5th in the 25 yd. free, 1:08.96.

In the 7 year old group **Nick Brown** placed 1st in the 50 yd. free, 47.80, 3rd in the 25 yd. free, 23.74, 5th in the 25 yd. back, 30.07. **Austin Mortimore** placed 1st in the 100 yd. IM, 2:04.46, 1st in the 50 yd. fly, 58.16, 2nd in the 25 yd. back, 24.27.

In the 9 year old group **Kaylee Boutwell** placed 9th in the 50 yd. free, 49.51, 9th in the 50 yd. back, 54.15.

Jocelyn Burks placed 8th in the 50 yd. free, 47.96, 11th in the 50 yd. back, 57.70.

In the 11 year old group **Kylee Burks** placed 2nd in the 50 yd. free, 32.38, 4th in the 50 yd. breast, 45.85, 3rd in the 100 yd. IM, 1:25.64, 4th in the 50 yd. fly, 41.62. **Caitlyn Camden** placed 5th in the 50 yd. free, 35.96, 6th in the 50 yd. breast, 53.82, 7th in the 100 yd.
