HELP!

We have used all of our pantyhose for the skimmers. If you have old pantyhose even if they are snagged please bring them to the pool! We use them as filters on our skimmers.

LAP SWIM PROBLEMS

One of our members suggested we set up a reserve system where a person would pay a fee to reserve a certain lane at a preset time. If the person reserving the lane was late they would forfeit the lane.

If we did this we would have to keep the center lane open and require users to circle swim and share the lane with as many as 6 swimmers. If you have thoughts on this let Joy know either by e-mail, note, or in person.

Several swim team members will be using lap time to improve their skills before the state meets in March. They will be swimming hard and making higher than normal wakes. Please be aware that their swimming is serious practice to improve their endurance and speed.

We never know what attendance to expect during lap swims. Thank you, lap swimmers, who are willing to share and move to another lane to accommodate newcomers or family groups.

POOL POTPOURRI

Since our pool is small we have to share it with others who may be taking swim lessons, swimming laps, water walking, doing their own prescribed exercises or participating in a fitness class.

We could actually have two fitness classes at the same time if we had the numbers; one in the deep water and one in the shallow water.

With winter coming the pool business will slow down and the building will once again belong to a single class at a time.

Despite some complaints all in all our daily swim lessons didn't interfere too much with our fitness classes.

The repair of a couple of the women's showers caused the most hardship. They are now back on line. The water had gotten behind the tiles and loosened them. The contractors decided to solve the water problem by making the entrance to shower a cement barrier.

ROSEBURG ROTARY OPEN MEET

Four athletes from the Rogue Valley Swim Team sponsored by Cascade Community Pool competed in the Roseburg Rotary Open Meet on July 20th. Fifteen teams made up of 272 swimmers entered the meet. The Rogue Valley Swim Team girls earned 4 personal bests.

In the 9 year old group **Jocelyn Burks** placed 11th in the 50 yd. free, 45.34, 6th in the 50 yd. fly, 53.82, 11th in the 100 yd. back, 2:10.40.

In the 12 year age group **Kylee Burks** placed 6th in the 50 yd. free, 31.25, 5th in the 100 yd. breast, 1:32.46. **Caitlyn Camden** placed 6th in the 50 yd. back, 42.07, 8th in the 50 yd. free, 34.00, 9th in the 100 yd. breast, 1:50.23. **Sarah Mortimore** placed 3rd in the 50 yd. free, 29.55, 2nd in the 50 yd. fly, 33.86.

Twenty six members of the team have signed up for competition in Grants Pass during the weekend of August 1st through the 3rd. The next weekend the team will travel to Coos Bay for their final meet of the summer season.

GRANTS PASS AQUATICS CLUB INVITATIONAL MEET

Austin Mortimore, eight year old athlete on the Rogue Valley Swim Team, captured the High Point Award with 56 points at the Grants Pass Aquatic Club Invitational held August 1st to 3rd. Twenty two swimmers from the team based at the Cascade Community Pool in White City competed against 202 athletes from 10 teams.

Three swimmers qualified at this meet for state: **Austin Mortimore**, 100 yd. IM, 100 free, 25 free, 50 free; **Aaron Hreha**, 100 yd. free, 100 yd. breast, 50 yd. free, **Stephen Camden**, 100 yd. free. Fifty personal best times were recorded by the team members. Coach, **Carleen Camden**, was pleased with her team's accomplishments.

In the 8 and under group **Charlotte Hreha** placed 9th in the 100 yd. free, 1:55.32, 9th in the 100 yd. IM, 2:11.87, 10th in the 25 yd. free, 22.31, 10th in the 50 yd. back, 1:05.70, 7th in the 25 yd. fly, 29.41, 8th in the 50 yd. free, 52.27, 8th in the 50 yd. breast, 1:04.59.

BIG KAHUNA SWIM MEET

The Rogue Valley Swim Team competed in the Big Kahuna Meet sponsored by the Gold Coast Swim Team August 8th through August 10th. Due to the Hawaiian theme of the meet the heat winners received leis. Fourteen teams composed of 268 swimmers competed in an outdoor pool in Coos Bay.

Due to the large numbers of entries the qualifying events involved many heats. Coach, **Carleen Camden** said, "There were 90 girls competing in the 100 yd. breast." Her team enjoyed their first time at this meet and they especially enjoyed the time on the beach after a long day's races. **Kylee Burks** had a great meet earning personal bests in all of her races.

In the 8 and under group **Austin Mortimore** placed 1st in the 100 yd. free, 1:30.47, 1st in the 25 yd. free, 16.97, 4th in the 25 yd. back, 25.05, 1st in the 50 yd. free, 39.75, 4th in the 25 yd. fly, 24.35.

In the 9 – 10 age group **Kaylee Boutwell** placed 11th in the 50 yd. fly, 52.48, 22nd in the 50 yd. breast, 1:07.10, 24th in the 100 yd. free, 1:33.23, 53rd in the 100 yd. back, 1:58.06, 30th in the 50 yd. free, 45.81. **Jocelyn Burks** placed 20th in the 50 yd. breast, 1:03.91, 37th in the 100 yd. free, 1:49.00, 33rd in the 50 yd. free, 48.97.

IM, 2:29.60, 15th in the 100 yd. back, 1:11.47, 11th in the 50 yd. free, 26.82, 8th in the 200 yd. free, 2:08.06.

In the 12 and Under 200 yd. relay **Jocelyn Burks, Caitlyn Camden, Kylee Burks, Sarah Mortimore** placed 5th, 2:21.59.

This was the last meet of the season. The team will have the first three weeks of September off.
