POOL & CARESOURCE

Our Board has approved a contract with CareSource which is a local health care plan. This means that if you have a plan with them they will pay half of your membership fee beginning January 1, 2009.

We have had to make some adjustments in the fee since they pay only single membership fees and no join fees. We have compensated for the join fee by changing the single price for plan participants to \$25 per month. A husband and wife each pay a single fee not a couple fee.

That also means you will not be able to add grandchildren to your membership.

Monthly we will bill Care Source for the other half of their client's fees. This means more bookkeeping on our part so we will try it for a year and see how it goes.

We hope to increase our membership and CareSource likewise will benefit from

more customers as well as keeping their clients healthy.

They adjusted their contract to fit our circumstances. For instance they want the pool to be available 7 days a week and we are not. They have also allowed us to delete the requirement of having a certain percentage of our members insure through their company.
