DONATIONS NEEDED!

Last February when we installed the new dehumidifier S & S Sheetmetal and Scott Vasak were trying to solve the problem we were having with the insulation above the new equipment filling with condensed water and then draining onto the dehumidifier and below the attic. For the remainder of the year they had buckets strategically placed to collect any water dripping from the insulation.

The correction of this problem was to be pushing the insulation, after it dried all summer, next to the metal roof and taping it in place.

Problems arose when the insulation was still wet. Scott had no idea how to bid this job so he bid it as materials and time.

After consultation with S & S Sheetmetal and a metal roofing expert they decided to tear out the insulation, replace it with a plastic material that adheres to

the metal roof, then install a firm insulation backed by foil that will be held in place with metal strips and tape. They want a barrier between the metal roof and the insulation so no warm air condenses on the inside of the cold roof.

We are waiting for the insulation to arrive before finishing the project.

This will cost \$6,300 for materials and \$3,700 for labor. We do not have the money and I have asked WCCIA and WCCF for \$5,000 each to cover this expense.

This morning I was told WCCIA would not donate the \$5,000. WCCF hasn't met to discuss the request.

This means we must ask our members & friends for donations to cover this expense. We are a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organization so your donations are tax deductible. **See pg. 2 for more bad news!**
