FUND RAISING PLANNED

As economic times affect all of us we are making plans for weathering the situation by making cuts where we can and launching a fund raising effort to cover expenses expected this year.

Our salt cell is working again, however we need to replace a cooling fan.

The pool drain must be changed to conform to the new law requiring a different drain cover. (We presently have the drain closed off until this done.)

We plan to do this next September. Since that means digging an additional drain in the bottom of the pool it makes sense to paint the inside of the pool as soon as the drain work is done.

It has been suggested we modify our steps into the pool to accommodate our disabled and older mem-

bers since the steps are so steep. This will be part of our wish list to be done during the drain revision. It will depend on how much money we can raise through donations and grants.

Our bingo sessions are barely covering their own expenses so we cannot rely on them to finance these additional projects.
