## POOL CLEANING CLOSURE

Friday, September 25th will be the last day the pool will be open until Monday, October 5th.

Since we do not have the funds to do major work on the pool we will settle for a good cleaning.

We will have the main drain plugged until such a time that we have enough money to add a second drain.

We will wash walls, floors, showers, etc. We will paint the outdoor entrance wood and the west wall in the pool building.

As many of you noticed, our entrance posts were damaged in a car accident so the new wood needs to be primed and painted. Since all the wood on the entrance structure hasn't been painted for nine years we will give it another coat which eliminates the need to match the paint exactly.

New light bulbs, and where needed, new ballasts for the darkened overhead lights will be installed. As the lights have been burning out we have installed new ballasts so we can use cheaper, locally available bulbs.

### SWIM TEAM DROPPED

The Board of Directors agreed to disband the Rogue Valley Swim Team for a year. If the economy improves and the Cascade Community Pool receives an additional \$200 a month in donations towards the team in addition to the student's monthly fees they will reconsider sponsoring the team. The Rogue Valley Swim Team competed admirably against much larger teams. Each and every one of them improved as they prac-

ted. Coach, Carleen Camden, gave a 110% towards her team, working extra hours at home and encouraging, directing, and mothering them at swim meets. We appreciate the many years she has dedicated to the team.

In the present economic times we need to use our pool to the biggest advantage to promote healthy families and a vibrant community. That means reaching more people with our limited income. Our free third grade "Water Safety" program involves approximately 300 children each year. We give scholarships for swim lessons to many other children. We offer fitness classes on a sliding scale according to income. We have not raised our open swim prices since we started in 1999 in order to provide a safe place for recreation in our community.

### WATER SAFETY CLASSES

The third graders from Eagle Rock Elementary School are currently participating in "Water Safety" classes at the pool.

The pool provides the eight lessons free of charge as well as pay for the transportation to and from the pool. By teaching two classes at once we cut the transportation costs.

White City Community Improvement Association in the

past has paid for all the White City third graders. We must look for donations to cover the costs for the rest of the Eagle Point children. This year we will be teaching the students from the Lake Creek Learning Center also. Since they have multi-grade levels we instruct their students every third year.

### POOL BOARD ELECTION

The Pool Board of Directors has an important part to play in the success of our pool. They set the policy and approve changes in the way we do business.

We are currently forming a five-year strategic plan for the pool which will become the basis for future decisions. We need this plan in place to apply for grants.

The three year terms for the following positions are up for reelection: Dorothy Stecker, Juliana Kelsall, Taylor Richardson. Lorane Zimmerman resigned from her position last winter and Cindy Sweet was appointed to complete her term which is also up for election.
