## SECURE SHED NEEDED

Twelve years ago the Fire Department informed us any gas-powered machine or gas can has to be stored away from an open flame so we bought a metal shed which had to be assembled. It wasn't long before some vandals managed to push the doors in and since that time though we padlock the doors it is not secure if someone pushes hard on them.

Two sets of gas-powered blowers and hedge trimmers have been stolen. Last spring they stole them just after the hedge trimmer had been repaired and serviced.

We have decided to replace the metal shed with a 10'x8' wooden one that can be more securely locked. We have an employee who could build a shed if we can get most of the materials donated.

If you have the following materials to donate please let Joy know.

- (2) 4x4x10
- (4) 4x4x8 treated
- (2) 2x4x10
- (34) 2x4x8
- (12) 2x4x6
- (9) siding (4x8T-111)
- (3) 1" + plywood (floor)
- (4) 1/2" plywood (decking)

### Roofing

- 1 square shingles (3 tab asphalt)
- 1 roll felt (15 Lb.)
- Miscellaneous (200) #16 nails
- (300) roofing nails
- (16) Redheads (4" or 5")

### Hardware

- (3) Hinges & bolts
- (1) Hasp & Bolts
- (50) 1 1/2" Drywall screws

When we get the materials we will construct the shed. In the meantime we are storing the gas-powered blower and hedge trimmer in the Joy's office.

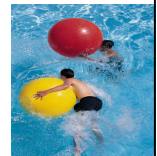
At 5:30 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. on Saturday, March 10th there will be a Pot Luck and Award Ceremony for the participants.
